- Reservations for groups can be made at the following site:

- Reservation times are made in blocks of ONE hour. This is from the reserved time, NOT the arrival time. Groups who arrive more than 10 minutes late for their reservation will be deemed cancelled.
- We will not be accepting reservations for ANY groups larger than 12 guests. No exceptions. This includes private groups and "join in" tours.
- Our operating hours will be 10AM-6PM daily beginning June 1, 2021. Last service for groups will be 4:30 PM.
- We will be offering wine and cider by the glass only for the groups from a limited, predetermined menu. Bottle purchases for consumption off site will be available as well. We will not be offering flights to large groups at this time.
- Seating will be outside only and weather dependent, please prepare your groups accordingly. Outside food or beverages are not permitted on the property.
- We are operating under current MDHHS restrictions which includes lowered capacity, mask wearing, social distancing, etc. There is no change in service protocols for vaccinated or unvaccinated individuals.
- Groups of 4 or less may use the patio or upper driveway seating.
 Groups of 5-12 will use their reserved group area <u>NO GROUPS</u>
 LARGER THAN 12 WILL BE PERMITTED.
- Our patio has been arranged to allow for the permitted occupancy allowed by law and spaced appropriately. We ask that you do not rearrange the tables or chairs.
- Guests are not permitted to drink in undesignated areas, their personal vehicles, or the parking lot. This includes drinking on buses or shuttles.

- Due to licensing restrictions, pets are not permitted on the patio or indoors. Pets are permitted on a leash in the vineyard seating area.
- All guests are required to wear a mask or facial covering until they are seated at a table. Our staff will be wearing face masks at all times.
- All guests are asked to adhere to a social distance of at least 6 feet from our staff and other guests.
- We will only be accepting credit cards payments. Cash payments will not be accepted at this time.
- We reserve the right to ask any guest to leave immediately if our safety guidelines are not followed. We also reserve the right to dismiss any person or persons from the premises should they be overly intoxicated, disrespectful to our team or grounds, belligerent, or otherwise disruptive.
- Peninsula Cellars promotes responsible drinking. Guests will be limited to 2 glasses of wine or cider each.
